As spring tiptoed in, so did scattered frost events, a reminder of nature's capricious ways. But our vines stood steadfast, their roots anchored in the promise of the season ahead. With the gentle touch of sunshine, flowering commenced—a symphony of life unfolding under clear skies.

Through the mild embrace of summer and early fall, our vineyard basked in the glow of the sun, each berry ripening with measured grace. And when the rains, so often heralds of autumn's arrival, held their peace, we knew fortune favored our fields.

From the heart of Prince Hill Vineyard emerges our 2022 Pinot Noir, a testament to heritage and legacy. Selected from Blocks 1 and 4, with over 90% born from the storied suitcase clone 95, this wine is a tribute to the vision of Dick Erath and the vine's journey from Clos de Vougeot to the soils of this site.

TASTING NOTES In the glass, a dance of dark cocoa, blackberry, and the whisper of fir tips unfurl. Concentrated yet nimble, its core pulsates with layers of flavor, while a savory finish lingers—a tribute to the harmony and complexity that define our wines. Here's to Prince Hill and the enduring spirit of Oregon's winemaking tradition.
