DUNDEE HILLS

Set high in the Dundee Hills, Prince Hill Vineyard offers sweeping views of the Willamette Valley and front-row access to the drama of Oregon's skies. The 2023 season began with a slow awakening. Cool spring temperatures delayed budbreak until late April, but a warm May spurred rapid growth and healthy canopy development. Summer brought stable conditions—no excessive heat, no heavy rain—keeping disease pressure low and allowing for precise vineyard work throughout the season. As harvest approached, a short cooling period and a touch of rain signaled the final countdown. Fruit was picked in over three measured weeks, just before autumn storms swept through the valley.

TASTING NOTES Crafted entirely from Clone 95, a rare and expressive Pinot Noir selection, this wine speaks clearly of its hillside origin. In the glass, it gleams with deep garnet color and striking clarity. Aromatically, it opens with bramble and marionberry layered over dried rose and earthy morel. As it evolves, notes of fresh berries, slate and warm spice emerge, offering both freshness and depth. The palate reveals dense, yet finely woven tannins wrapped around black cherry and Italian plum. A core of vibrant acidity keeps the wine lifted and long, guiding the finish into savory territory—high desert sage, white pepper and a hint of game. The 2023 Prince Hill Pinot Noir captures a season of restraint and balance. It is a precise and elegant expression of clone and site, shaped by thoughtful farming and the quiet strength of the Dundee Hills.
